





7 Formatting a Wallpaper Image

To	Do This
Scale the image to fit your phone screen while maintaining the image proportions	Select Scale to Fit in the drop-down menu.
Stretch the image to fit your phone screen	Select Stretch to Fit in the drop-down menu.
To enable the zoom functionality	Select Resize and position from the drop-down menu.
Zoom in on the image	Select the Resize and position in the drop-down menu, and slide the magnification cursor towards  .
Zoom out on the image	Select the Resize and position in the drop-down menu, and slide the magnification cursor towards  .
Rotate the image 90 degrees to the right	Click  .
Rotate the image 90 degrees to the left	Click  .

To	Do This
Import a wallpaper image from your computer	Click Import on the Wallpaper pane.
Delete a selected wallpaper image	Select Edit > Delete .
View the properties of a selected wallpaper image	Select File > Properties .



1 Installing the Application

Before installing Phone Designer your system administrator should ensure that your equipment meets the system requirements for using this product.

To install the application you must have Administrator privileges and at least 80MB of free disk space on your computer.

-
- Step 1** Obtain the installer (.exe file) from your system administrator.
 - Step 2** Double-click the installer and follow the installation instructions.
 - Step 3** To launch the application, select **Start > Programs > Cisco Phone Designer > Phone Designer**, or double-click the Phone Designer desktop shortcut.




Note If you are upgrading the application, when asked if you wish to remove all Phone Designer components, select No to retain your user credentials and your personal ringtones and wallpaper images.

2 Selecting a Ringtone




-
- Step 1** Highlight a ringtone in the Ringtone Collection.
 - Step 2** Perform one of the following actions:
 - Click **Preview on Phone** to preview the ringtone on your Cisco Unified IP Phone.
 - Click **Save to Phone** to save the ringtone to your Cisco Unified IP Phone.
 - Drag and drop the highlighted ringtone into the phone image in the Ringtones pane. The selected ringtone is automatically saved to your Cisco Unified IP Phone.

3 Editing a Ringtone

-
- Step 1** Highlight a ringtone in the Ringtone Collection.
 - Step 2** Select **Edit > Edit Ringtone**.
 - Step 3** Click on any location in the ringtone editing window and move the cursor right or left to highlight a ringtone selection. The ringtone length must be between one second and twenty seconds.
 - Step 4** Click  to play the ringtone selection.

- Step 5** Click **Save** to save the ringtone selection.

4 Recording a New Ringtone

-
- Step 1** Select **File > Record Ringtone**.
 - Step 2** Select a Device type.
 - Step 3** Select the input Source type. A built-in microphone is the default setting.
 - Step 4** Define a name for your ringtone recording.
 - Step 5** Click  to record your ringtone. You can click  to stop the ringtone recording.
 - Step 6** Click  to play your ringtone recording.
 - Step 7** Click **Save** to save your ringtone recording.

View the properties of a selected ringtone	Select File > Properties .

6 Selecting a Wallpaper Image

-
- Step 1** Click on a thumbnail image in the Wallpaper Collection.
 - Step 2** Perform one of the following actions:
 - Click **Preview on Phone** to preview the wallpaper image on your Cisco Unified IP Phone.
 - Click **Save to Phone** to save the wallpaper image to your Cisco Unified IP Phone.
 - Drag the selected wallpaper image to the phone image in the Wallpaper pane. The selected wallpaper image is automatically saved to your Cisco Unified IP Phone.
