Software maintenance support for Cisco Jabber for Windows, Mac and VDI version 12.1.x and 12.5.x end on **July 31, 2021**. No patches or maintenance releases will be provided for Cisco Jabber for Windows, Mac and VDI version 12.1.x and 12.5.x after that date.

Software maintenance requires an active service contract.
